Cultural Arts Grants, as determined by the City Arts Commission, will be awarded to qualified arts organizations with strong projects that enhance arts education and community programs. Successful applicants must propose projects/programs for funding that directly benefit children, youth, adults and seniors in Newport Beach, as well as schools within the City's geographic boundaries. Applicants must also be able to document need, quantifiable success, a realistic budget and an implementation plan.

Last year's grantees were reminded to submit their completion reports by Friday, September 27, in order to be eligible for consideration for this year's grant opportunities.
