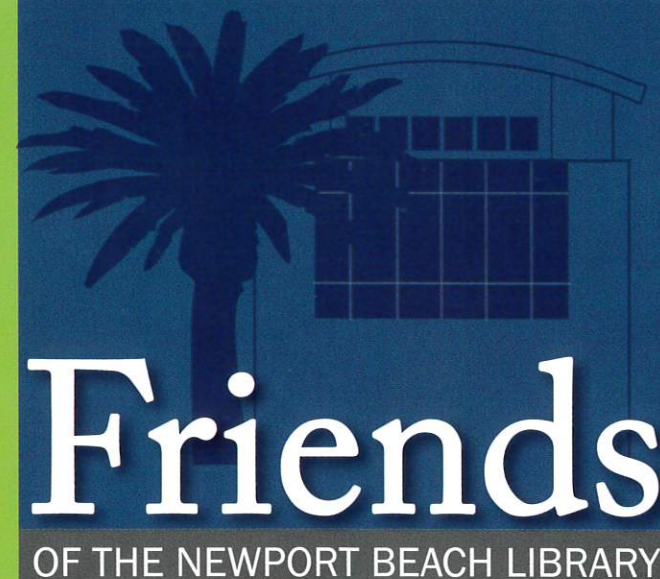

What do Friends do?

Bookstore

The Friends operate a used bookstore in the Central Library, manned by a volunteer staff of over 100 dedicated individuals. The bookstore is open Monday-Saturday 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and on Saturday 10:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Books donated by the public are sorted and priced, then sold in the store. Prices range from 50 cents to \$100, but most books are sold for 50 cents to \$3. Books of special value are offered for sale on the internet through Amazon or an auction house. In addition, books discarded by the library are sold at minimal prices in the store.
