It is time to start working on your "Roles and Goals" forms. Our goal is to receive a form for every learner who participated in the program in 2023 (through June 30).

Tutors and learners are evaluated based on the California Library Literacy Services learner-centered "Roles and Goals" framework. This framework supports our mission to develop the literacy skills of adults, empowering them to achieve greater success in their lives.

The framework helps:

- Identify the goals that learners want to accomplish with their improved literacy skills.
- Deliver learner-centered instruction that is tailored to learners' goals and aspirations.
- Track, acknowledge, and celebrate progress.
- Evaluate the impact of the library literacy program.

Goal-setting empowers learners! It helps learners reflect on what brought them to the program, define what they want to work on, take ownership of their instruction, keep focused, stay motivated, and build self-confidence.

Goal-setting within the framework helps learners achieve success in their major life roles as community members, workers, family members, and lifelong learners.

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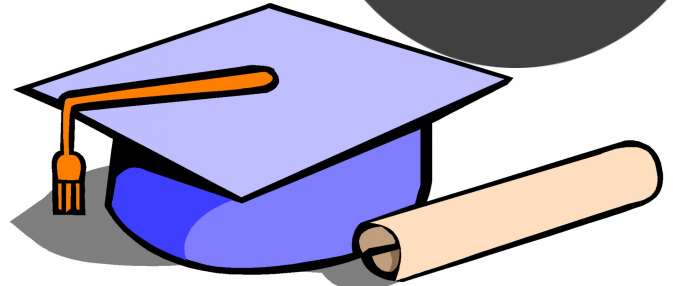
