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Tutor Resource: Workplace Literacy

Many of our learners are curious to explore new job possibilities but want to get a better handle on their own strengths and weaknesses. Traitify is a website that offers a free, short assessment test that shows users 60 pictures of different personality traits and users choose "Me" or "Not Me" for each picture. For example, one picture shows an exotic food and reads "New Experiences" at the top and the user chooses "Me" or "Not Me." **Traitify has other paid uses, but this website is free and accessible to anyone providing a name and email address.**

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At the end of the assessment test, users will get a description designed to match their interests and strengths along with a video that provides more details. Tutors are recommended to use their learners results as an opportunity to help learners explore their job-related strengths and potential careers.

Instructions

- The form will be available in the office, online, and in the America Learns July Monthly Report.

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Learners, are you ready to become published authors? We encourage you to submit an original story, article, essay, poem and more for our next edition of "In Our Own Words."


Submission Requirements:
