## **CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY**

- Submissions are limited to one (1) work of art per artist. Entry forms are required for participation.
- Entries will be accepted in person only at the Central Library located at 1000 Avocado Ave. Please do not bring artwork to other Newport Beach library branches.
- 3. Artwork size limit: 9" x 12" and must be unframed.
- Each entry must be an original work of art and not violate U.S. copyright laws. Unaccepted artwork includes copies from existing photos or images created by someone other than the applicant.
- The City Arts Commission retains the right to reject entries that are deemed inappropriate for public display.
- 6. For the purpose of exhibiting at the Library, all accepted artworks will be adhered onto foam core for mount and display. Please be aware that artwork will be returned in this manner and that removal of art from the foam core may cause damage to it. By submitting art into the exhibition, the entrant accepts that the City shall not be held responsible for any damage to the artwork caused as a result of such attempts.

## SUBMISSION OF ARTWORK

Artists will have between **Monday, October 6** until **Sunday, November 30, 2025** to submit their applications. Artists must submit their entries **in-person** to the Children's Room on the 1st floor of the Central Library.

#### **ART EXHIBIT**

Artwork will be on display from **Tuesday**, **January 6**, **2026**, until **Monday**, **February 23**, **2026**.

Art will be mounted on foam core and displayed on the 1st floor.

## **ARTWORK RETRIEVAL**

Artists will have between Monday, March 2 through Sunday, March 15, 2026, to pick up their artwork from the Central Library in the Children's Room on the 1st floor.

## **JUDGING**

Entries must be received by **Sunday, November 30, 2025.** Entries will be judged based on creativity, quality, and originality.

Winners will be notified via the contact information provided at the time of entry. Please do not contact us about the status of entries or judging.

## **PRIZE DETAILS**

Prizes are divided into three categories with nine winners overall: grades Pre-K - 3rd, grades 4 - 7th, and grades 8 – 12th. Winners will be invited to attend an award ceremony in early February 2026.

All participants will receive a certificate of participation through the email provided at the time of their registration. Please note that a certificate of participation *does not* indicate a prize award.
