

We are excited to announce our new partnership with Huntington Beach Adult School! Huntington Beach Adult School (HBAS) is an adult education institution that is dedicated to promoting lifelong



learning and preparing students for success in further education, the workforce, and the community.

They offer several programs including: English as a Second Language classes, ESL Citizenship classes, Career Readiness classes, Computer Skills classes, Personal Development and Skill Building classes.

These relevant, rigorous and innovative programs can help adult achieve their academic, personal and professional goals.

In addition, HBAS offers FREE Career Training programs designed to prepare students for specific careers such as: Accounting Clerk, Administrative Assistant, Business Information Worker, Medical Assistant, Medical Billing & Coding, Pharmacy Technician, Paraprofessional and School Bus Driver. Some of these programs can be completed in as little as 9 months.

Helping students reach their goals is a team effort, which is why HBAS is fortunate to partner with colleges, businesses, government agencies and non-profit organizations including Project Adult Literacy. The Writer to Writer Challenge is GOING ON NOW and we are encouraging EVERY LEARNER to participate! Writer to Writer is a California-based reading/writing competition where you read a book or listen to an audiobook in English and write a letter to an author. This challenge is at the core of literacy.

This is a great opportunity for learners to write, to express their voice in a safe and trusted environment and to work on goals related to their yearly Roles & Goals.

Winners will receive a cash prize and are invited to attend an awards ceremony at The Southern California Library Literacy Network Conference in March 2026. All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation plus they will have their writing published in a special Writer to Writer booklet!


PAL COMMUNITY EVENT: Holiday Potluck
